



Formerly the quarter of the tanners, millers and fishers, it is now a heaven of peace in the heart of the city. The streets are lined with half-timbered 16th and 17th c. houses with vast internal courtyards and equally vast, steeply sloping roofs with open lofts where the skins used to be dried.

5 THE COVERED BRIDGES

They have kept their name although the roofs disappeared in the 18th century. They are overlooked by four 14th century towers, remains of the old city walls.

> THE NEUSTADT DISTRICT

> THE DISCOVERY CENTRES

Built after the German annexation between 1871 and 1918. the *Neustadt* district tripled Strasbourg's surface area and made it a showcase for the German Empire. It is characterised by wide roads, imposing administrative buildings, affluent residential buildings and artfully designed landscaping.



PIACE DE LA RÉPUBLIQUE

The former *Kaiserplatz*, prettily lined with trees, is surrounded by majestic examples of this imperial architecture, such as the Palais du Rhin, the University Library and the National Theatre. At the centre stands the war memorial erected in 1936: it represents a mother with her two sons, one who died for France, and the other for Germany; a dramatic situation experienced by the Alsatians during both world wars.

(D) THE ORANGERIE PARK

is a cool heaven in the heart of summer. Empress Josephine loved walking there when she stayed in the pavilion named after her. With the boats on the lake, the little zoo. the storks and the children's games, the park is a very popular place with the locals


